What do we be doing for 2017, we're trying to develop collaborative autonomy. So we are developing a framework, which will enable interoperability between vehicles.

What else are we doing? Well, we're also looking at planning and evaluation of system of systems. We're trying to develop a tool, or an approach that will combine different vehicles together and make sure that the overall mission is successful.

So 2017 were really focusing on how we can standardize the way we describe a system. The Greek Mine Ex was very exciting for the first time, because we had different types of vehicles, different sensors, we were able to find all the targets and we were able to provide a portfolio of images of these targets.

2018 what are we going to do? Well we are open to collaborations, to nations coming to work with us, we're looking at participating in different types of operation. We will carry on with our collaborative autonomy framework, developing it further, adding more collaborative behaviors. We will carry on with our planning and evaluation tool - and we will also carry on with our flagship ATR.
