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

- » Prevention
- » Intervention

Suicide Prevention Program (SPP)

- » Everything in one document
- » For us
- » For our stakeholders

SPP: Prevention

- » Education and training programs
- » Communications
- » Reduce barriers (stigma)
- » Treatment of mental illness

SPP: Intervention

- » Suicidal risk screening
- » Clinician's Handbook on suicidality
- » Substance use
- » Coordination of care: Most Responsible Physician (MRP)
- » Post-suicide attempt interventions

SPP: Postvention

- » Support to family/friends/colleagues
- » Support to health care providers

SPP: Investigations

- » Chart review for attempted suicides
- » Medical Professional Technical Suicide Review (MPTSR)

SPP: Performance Measurement

- » Surveillance, research, and analysis
 - » Report on Suicide Mortality in CAF
 - » MPTSRs
