
Canadian Federal Search and Rescue





CAF SAR MANDATE

- Ensure effective operation of the co-ordinated aeronautical and maritime SAR system
- Co-ordinate, control and conduct aeronautical SAR Ops
- Provide aeronautical SAR response services
- Assist maritime and ground SAR incident



Canada's SAR Area of responsibility is 18,000,000 km², with the world's longest coastline






