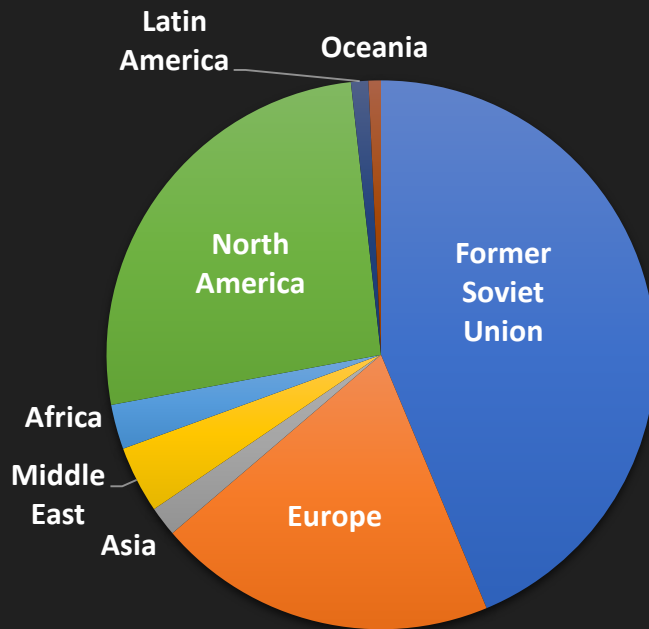
Data Sources

- Using instances of Russian rhetorical jabs as the primary data
- Obtained from official Russian government sources and select pro-Kremlin media (Izvestiya, TASS, RIA)
- Violence limited to physical violence
- Measuring for correlation with Russian military actions directed against other states also as reported by Russian media

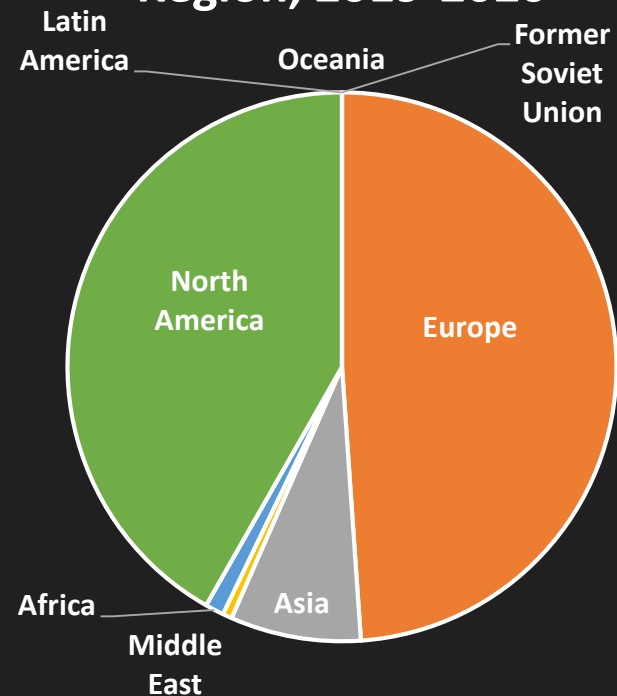


Breakdown of Data by Region

Russian Rhetoric on Violence by Region, 2019-2020

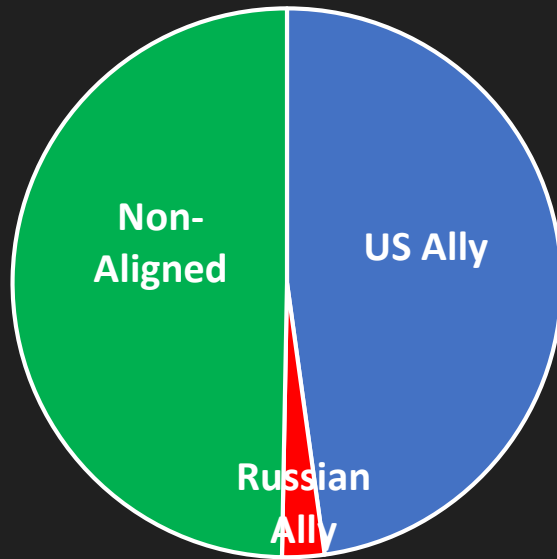


Russian Military Demonstrations of Force by Region, 2019-2020

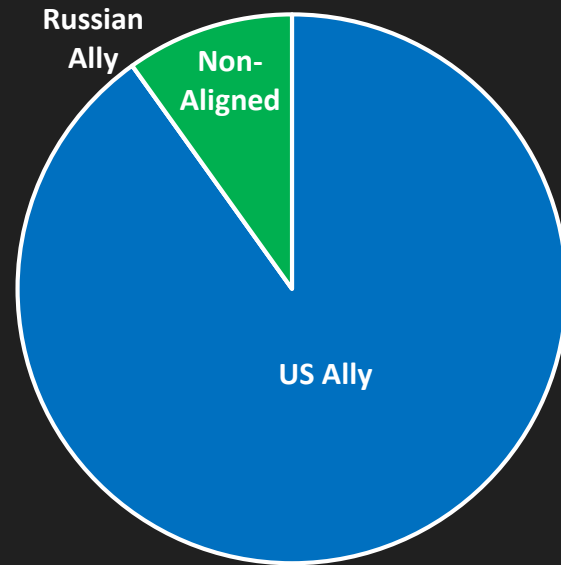

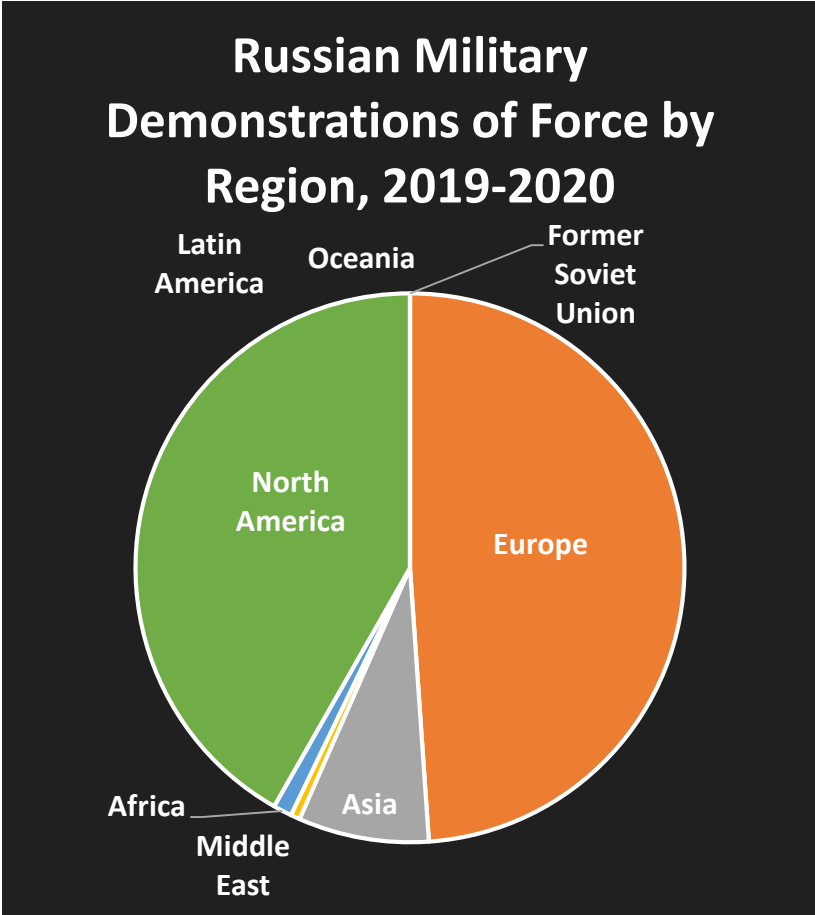
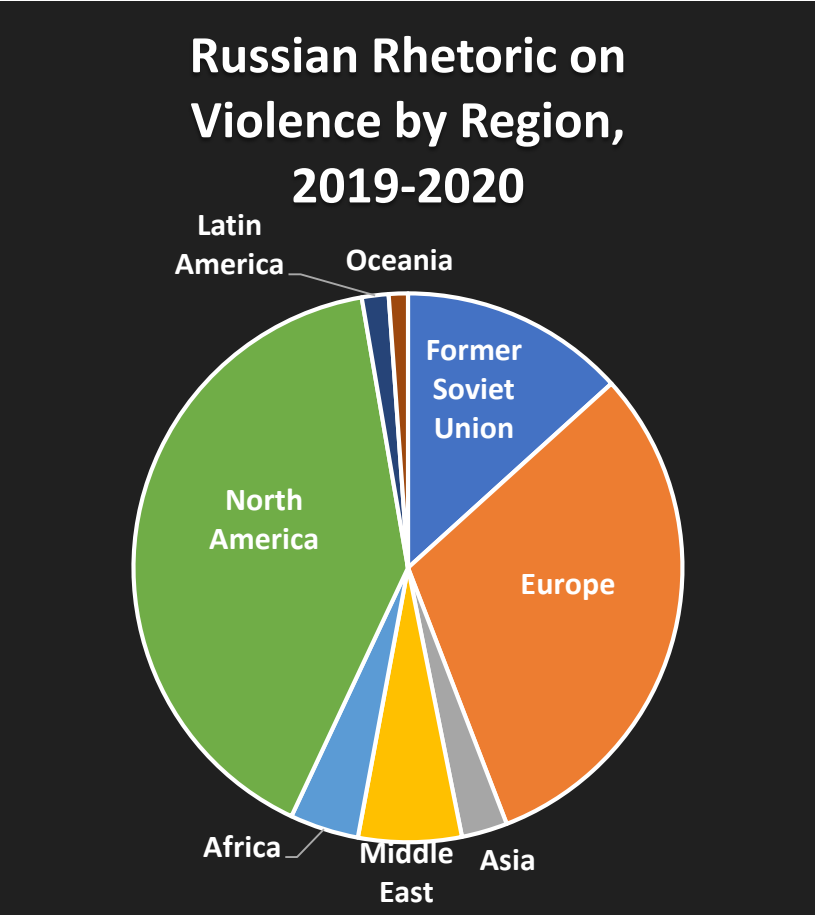
Russian Rhetoric on Violence by Alliance, 2019-2020



Russian Military Demonstrations of Force by Alliance, 2019-2020

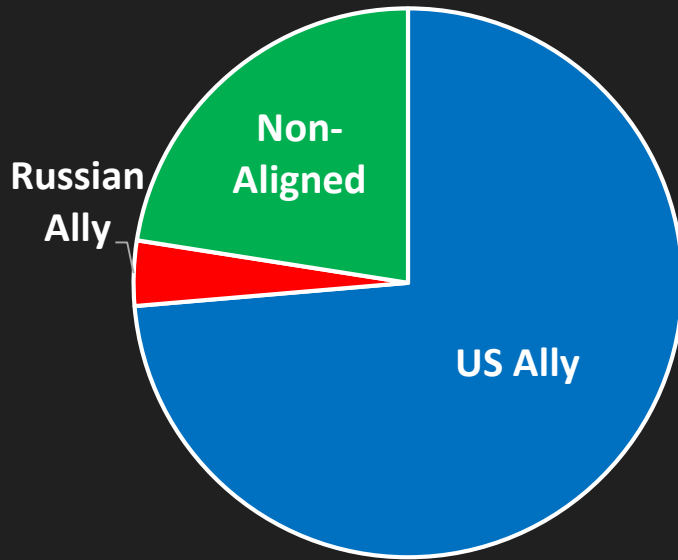


Breakdown of Data by Region except Ukraine

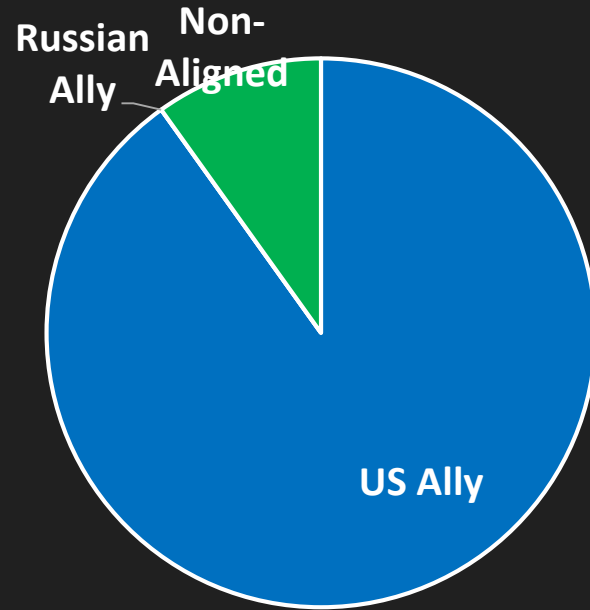


Breakdown of Data by Alliance except Ukraine

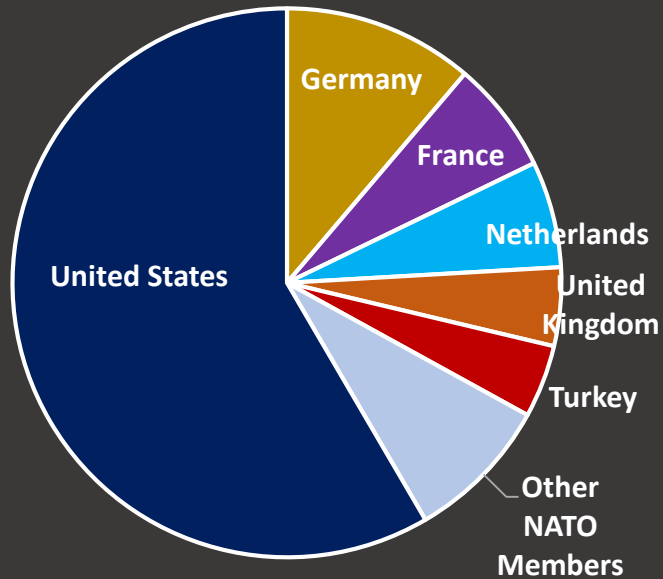

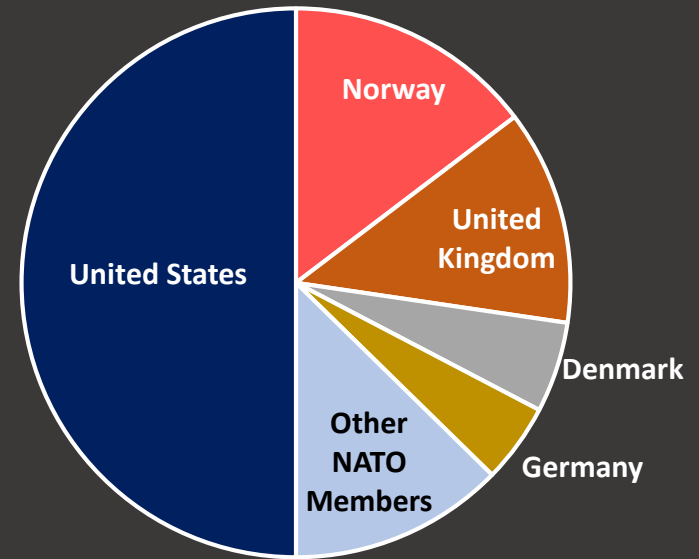


Russian Rhetoric vs Action by NATO Member State

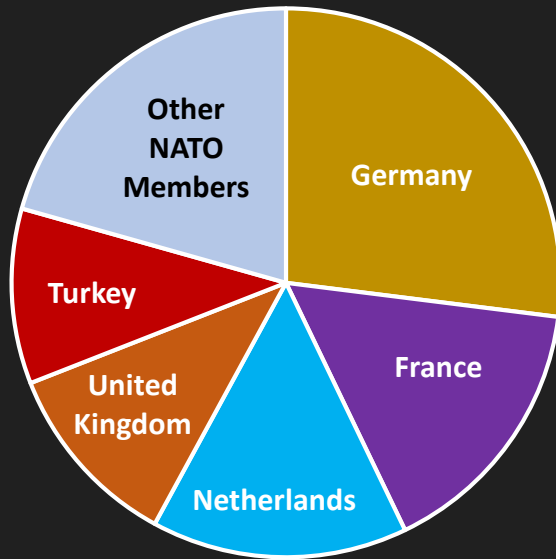


Russian Military Demonstrations of Force, 2019-2020

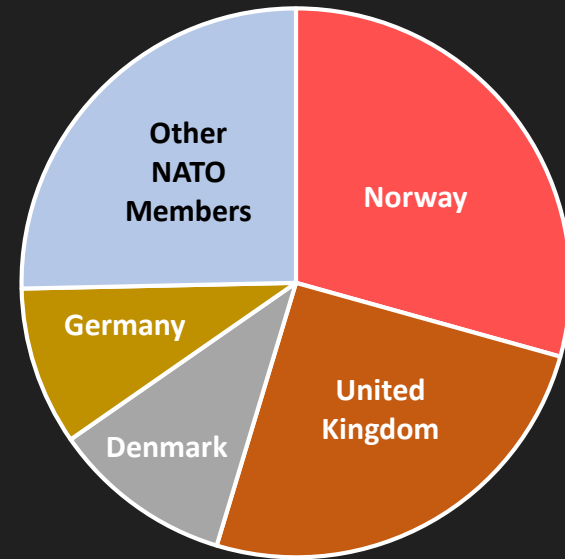


Russian Rhetoric vs Action by NATO Member State except USA

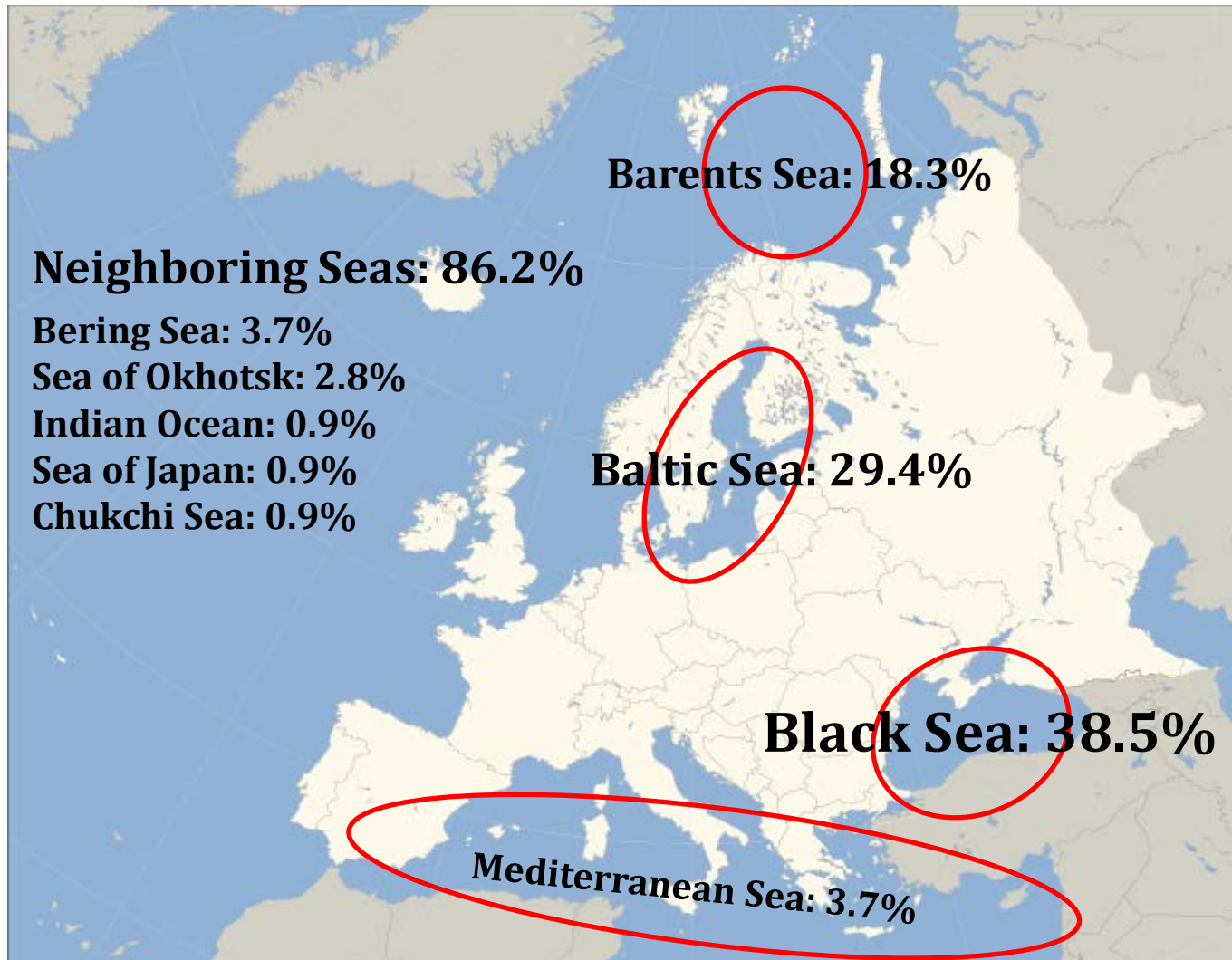
