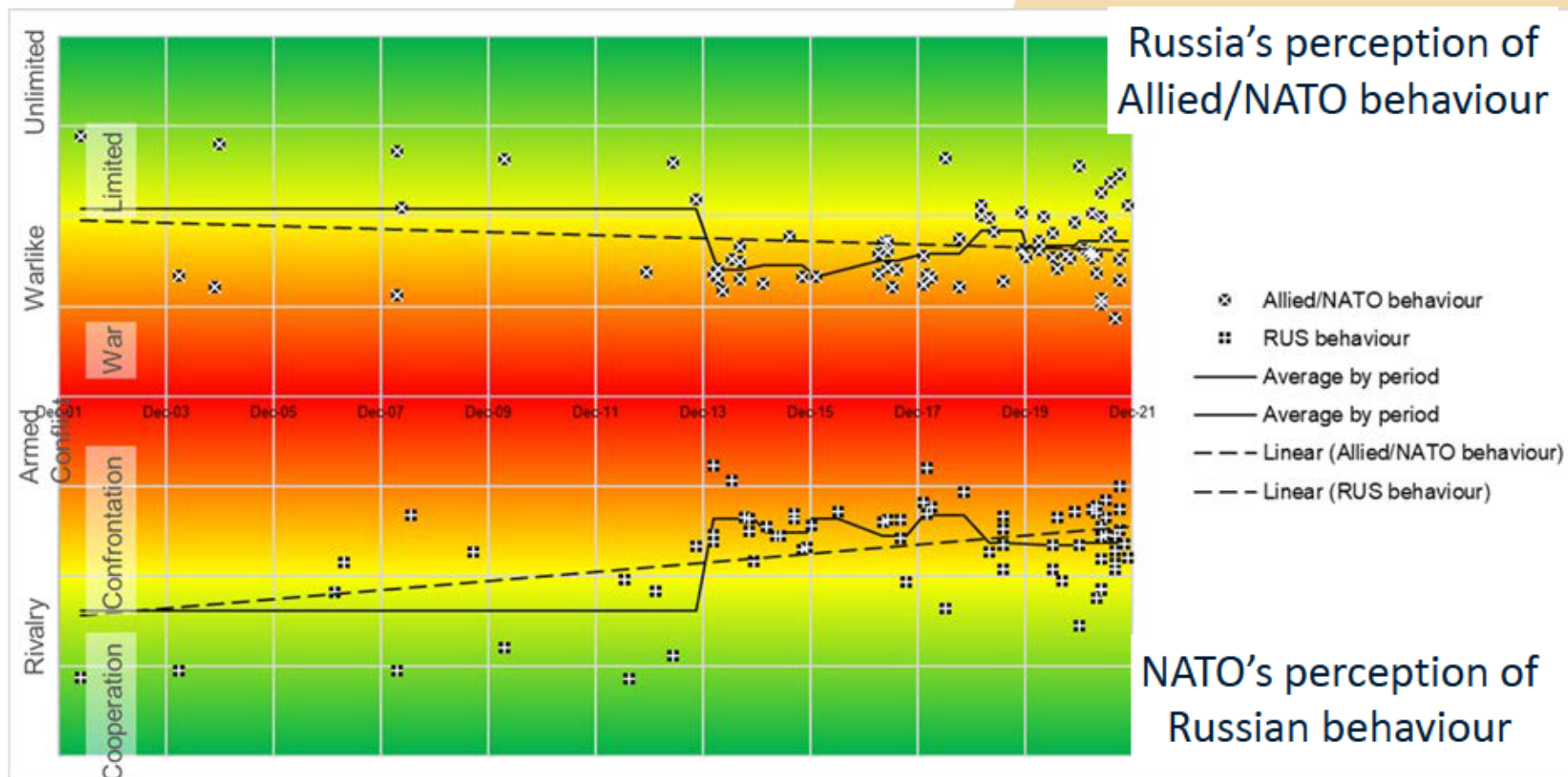

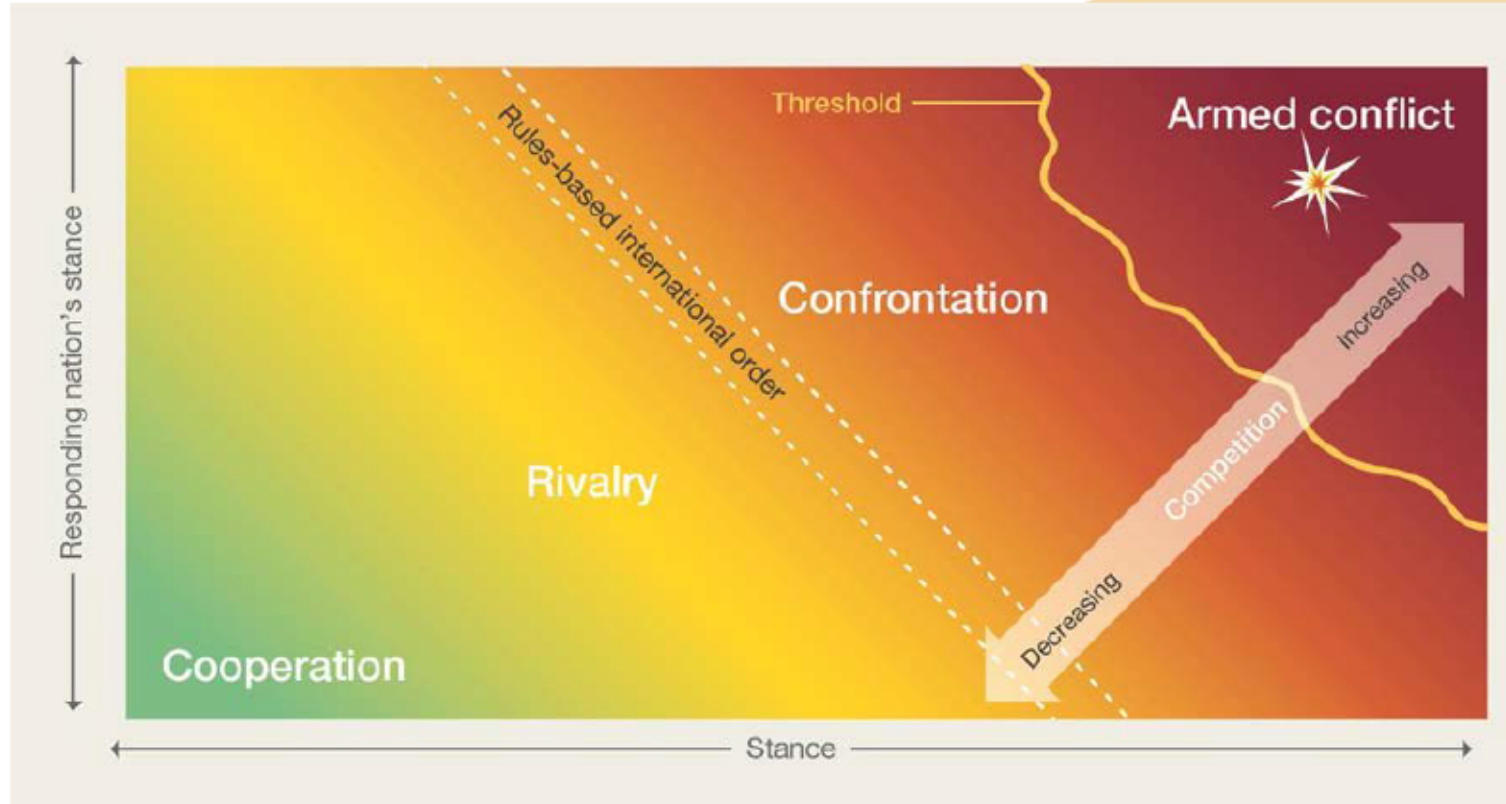

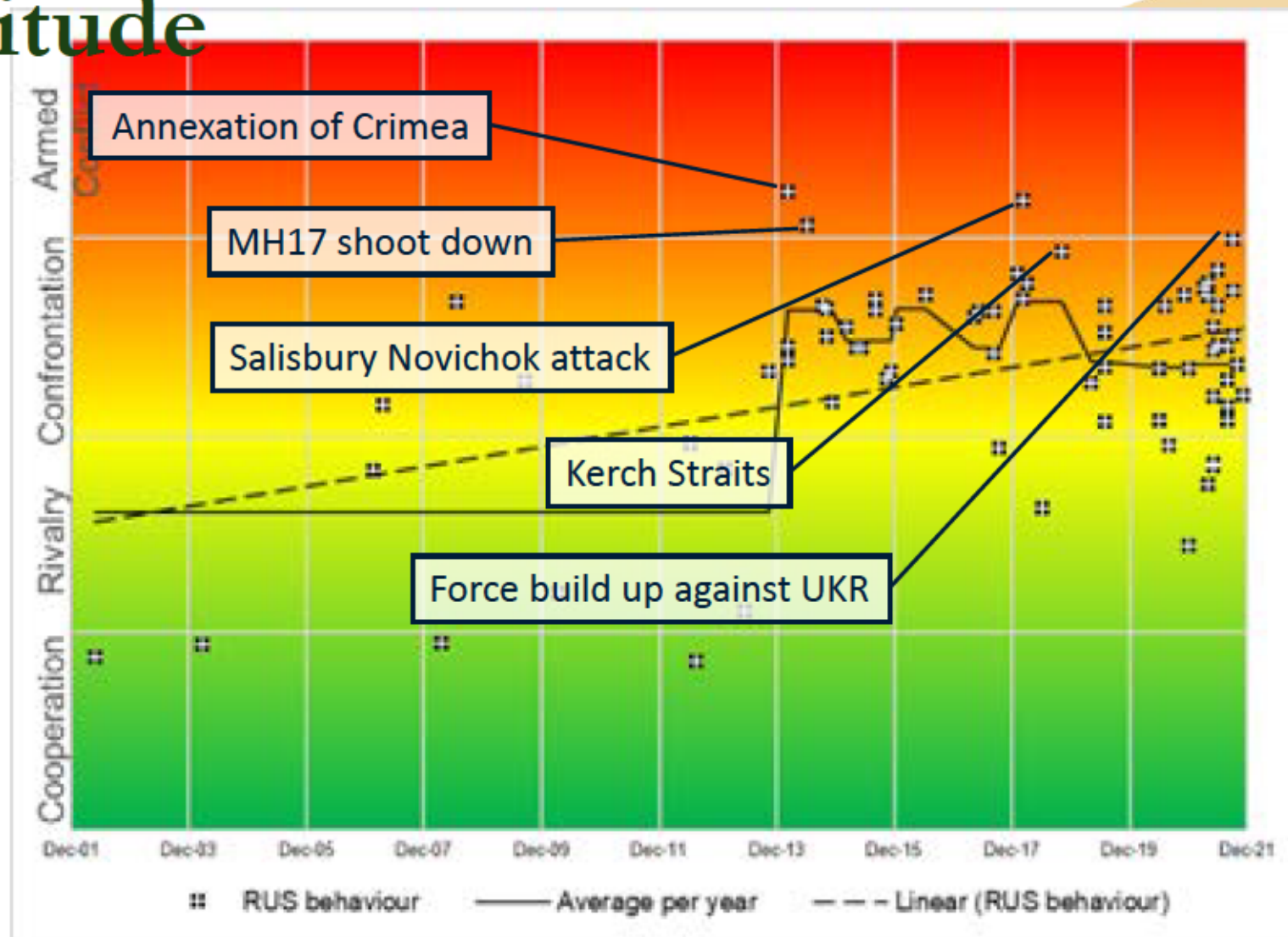

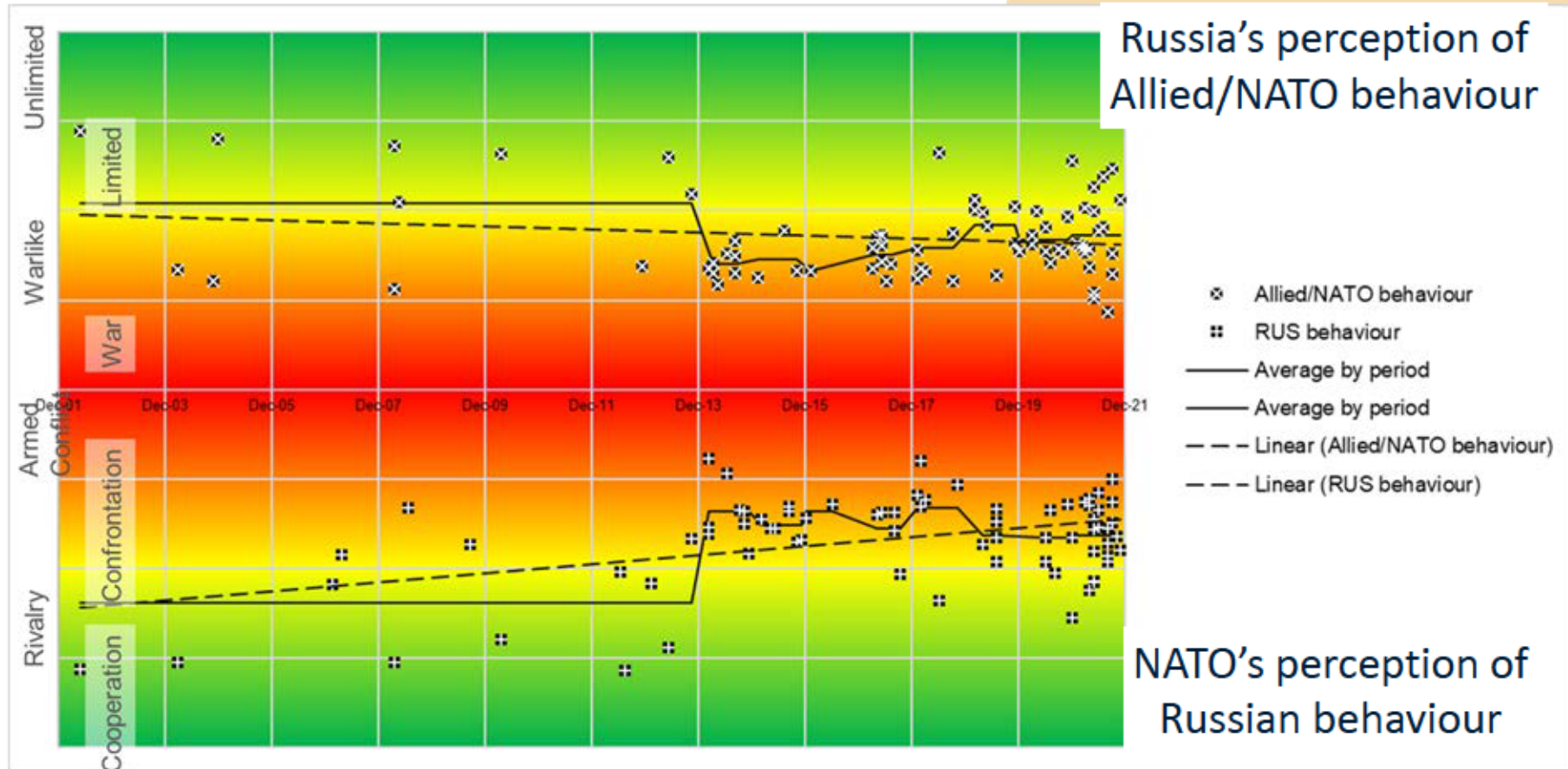
NATO's Perception of Russian Behaviour and Attitude



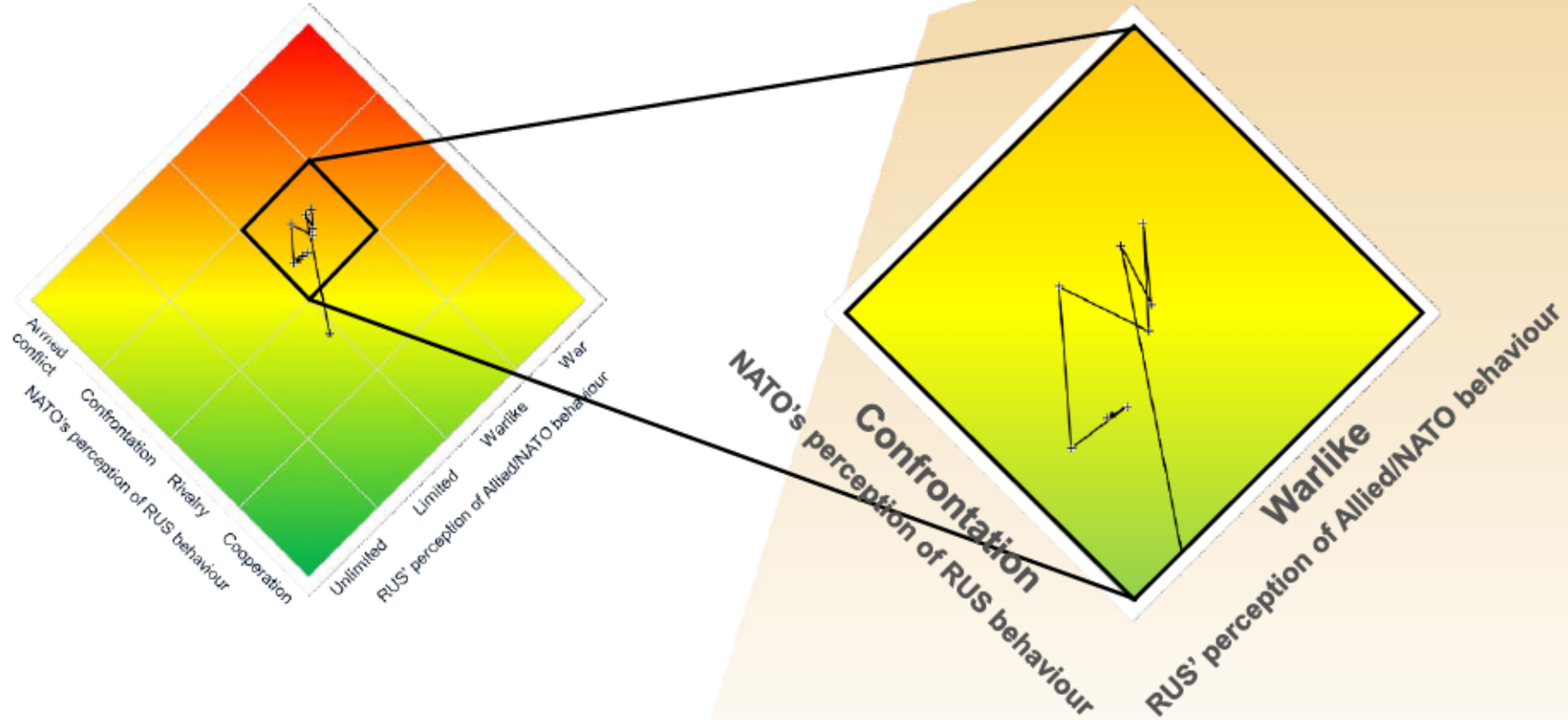
